



State-funded support measures for people with protection status S

Free support measures

The canton of Zurich has an established support system in place for refugees. It includes a wide range of measures to promote the integration of refugees. These services are also available to persons from the Ukraine with protection status S who are registered with the social service where they live. The costs of the courses are covered by the municipality (social service). Examples of integration support services:

- **German courses for different learning levels (A1 to B2) and intensities, both with and without childcare assistance (support area ‘Language’)**
- Educational opportunities for teenagers and young adults that could lead to vocational training (support area ‘Education’)
- Coaching for adults to help them find work and keep their existing job skills up to date (support area ‘Work integration’)
- External work assignments in the private sector, non-profit organisations or public administration (support area ‘Work integration’)
- Tandem programmes: Volunteers accompany refugees and help them familiarise themselves with their local area and everyday life (complementary cantonal services)
